Literacy:

During literacy this term we will be reading: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe, The Egyptian Cinderella and looking at examples of other "voyage and return" stories.

Using these texts the children will be writing: their own voyage and return story set i

Ancient Egypt; a playscript based on The Egyptian Cinderella, instructions on how to mummify a tomato as well as descriptions of character and setting.

Children will have weekly guided reading sessions to help with their comprehension and weekly spelling tests.

To help your child at home please could you read with them every night and support them in practising their spellings.

Music.

This term we will be following the Charanga unit "Let your spirit fly"
